Later, when children are sure to put piles of objects together, they can move on to number lines or count on in the head. Once children have understood this, they can begin to learn their additions facts and progress on to column additions. At the fourth and fifth grade levels, they begin to add decimal places. Knowing your addition facts is still an important skill that children need to be able to use in real life mathematics – you may not always have a pencil and paper at hand to make the column addition, but you will always have your add-on facts!
