By 1917, a more recognizable version was published in a collection of World War I songs: Old Macdougall had a farm in Ohio-i-o, and on that farm he had some dogs in Ohio-i-o, with a bow-wow here, and a bow-wow there, here a bow, there's a bow, there's a wow, all over a bow-wow. The most modern version simply rolls off a variety of barnyard animals with accompanying sounds, each verse adding the previous sound to a long string until the end of the song, children are mooing, reaching, barking, meowing, quacking, and clucking. The song can continue as long as the singers have patience and can think of new animals to add to the repertoire.
